Homework

When homework is assigned, it is due the next day unless otherwise stated by the teacher. Students lose 5 points for each day late and it is 5% of a student's grade.

It is the student's responsibility to study the concepts and vocabulary learned in class daily, and to complete the practice activities provided by the teacher to reinforce these concepts.

Late Work

Late work will be accepted with a deduction of 5 points for each day late.

Explanation of Zeroes

A zero will not be assigned for tests/quizzes and performance assessments. The minimum score for classwork and homework that has been turned in will be 50%.

Reassessment

Students scoring 64 or below on assessments such as unit tests/quizzes, and speaking or writing performance tasks will have the opportunity to retake another version of the same assessment when certain provides are met, such as class participation, completed assignments, and evidence of best efforts.

The reassessment needs to be requested by the student and completed **within a week** of the original test/assessment

Make-up Work

Make up work due to absence will be accepted late without penalty equivalent to the number of days a student was absent.

Extra Credit

Extra credit is given throughout the nine weeks embedded in warm ups, quizzes and other class activities.
